**Nuestro Mundo/Our World:** Beginning Spanish for students entering grades 1-4.

In this week-long class, students will learn basic commands, vocabulary words, and phrases through singing, games, and movement.

**Math on the Menu:** Math camp for students entering grades 2-5.

The week will culminate with students ordering, making,

**Writing in the Garden:** Writing class for students entering grades 2-5.

Students will write paragraphs and stories about the outdoors and garden using different genres, including: poetry, descriptive, and personal narrative. Each student will produce a Garden Book using a stick-binding technique, which will integrate drawing with their final-draft writing.

**Back-to-School Basics:** Reading, writing, and math review for students in grades 2-5.

After a fun and relaxing summer break, join me for a gentle reentry into the work of reading, writing, and mathematical computation, just in time for the start of school! Phonics, grammar, spelling, sight words, and math facts will be reviewed.

**Fee:** \$150 per student, per week. Deposit of \$50 per class per student due by June 1st, 2012.

**Other:** Minimum class size of 5 students per session must be met by June 1st or the session will be cancelled. No more than 15 students will be enrolled in each session. \$50 deposit due by June 1st; make checks payable to SBAC.

Students may be signed into the After School Program with parental permission and pre-made arrangements with the ASP Summer Camp. Usual ASP Camp fees apply. Parents are responsible for transporting their son/daughter to ASP Summer Camp at Goleta Beach on Tuesday and Thursday, if applicable.
