In this week-long class, students will learn basic commands, vocabulary words, and phrases through singing, playing games, and movement.

Build-It Festival

Math Camp for students entering grades 2-5.



Weaving mathematics concepts into engaging, hands-on construction activities, this GEMS festival includes a wide assortment of activities that emphasize construction, geometric challenges, and spatial visualization. Students will make two- and three-dimensional shapes with blocks, follow paper patterns, work with pattern blocks, create tessellations, explore symmetry, and build structures with newspaper dowels.

Writing in the Garden

Writing Class for students entering grades 2-5.



Students will write paragraphs and stories about the outdoors and garden using five different genres: poetry, persuasive, descriptive, personal narrative, and response to literature. Each student will make a Garden Journal using a stick-binding technique, and will produce a Garden Book, which will integrate drawing with all of their final-draft writing.

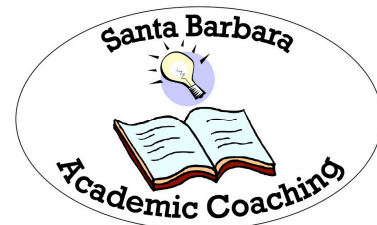
Summer School with Laura Donner

Students may be signed into the After School Program with parental permission and pre-made arrangements with the ASP Summer Camp. Usual ASP Camp fees apply. Parents are responsible for transporting their son/daughter to ASP Summer Camp at Goleta Beach on Tuesday and Thursday, if applicable.
